BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Forfeiture of license and vehicle in absence of financial responsibility. A person required to furnish proof of financial responsibility under Title 53, chapter 4. R.C.M. 1947, who fails to do so and is the cause of an accident is subject to loss of a license to operate a motor vehicle in Montana for a period of 1 year for the first offense and not more than 5 years for the second offense and forfeiture of the motor vehicle involved in the accident to the person injured or whose property was damaged in the accident should the uninsured motorist be unable to pay for damages he incurred. The penalties provided in this section are in addition to any other penalties provided in Title 53, chapter 4, R.C.M. 1947.
