 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from
 10 the general fund the sum of \$300,000 to the department of
 11 agriculture for the purpose of providing matching funds as
 12 provided in 3-3504 and 3-3506 in implementing the insect
 13 control programs specified in 3-3501 through 3-3506. This
 14 appropriation is made subject to the receipt of matching
 15 funds in the manner specified in 3-3504 and 3-3506.

16 Section 2. Funds revert. Any unexpended funds as of
 17 June 30, 1979, shall revert to the general fund.

18 Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective on
 19 its passage and approval.
