DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to provide for the cancellation of registry for failure to vote after each general election.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. There would be no state expenditures or savings.
2. Costs to the counties would be additional employee time in one year out of four and costs of notification of cancellation one year out of four.
3. Fewer voters would be cancelled after each election than is now the case with cancellation every four years.

FISCAL IMPACT - STATE:

None.

FISCAL IMPACT - LOCAL GOVERNMENT:

The total cost to all counties in the state in FY 79 would approximate \$38,000;

Cancellation costs (\$250 per county for personal services)	\$14,000
Notification costs (\$0.40 per notice X 60,000 cancellations)	<u>24,000</u>
