4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN 5 ENLISTMENT BONUS UPON A FIRST ENLISTMENT IN THE MONTANA 6 NATIONAL GUARD."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Enlistment bonus for first enlistment in 10 national guard. (1) Upon a first enlistment in the Montana 11 national guard, an enlisted member becomes entitled to a 12 bonus of \$150 for each year of his enlistment period. The 13 first bonus is payable upon enlistment and annually 14 thereafter upon the anniversary of the enlistment.

15 (2) In lieu of the cash bonus provided by subsection 16 (1) of this section, the member may elect to receive a 17 voucher that entitles him to \$150 each year in tuition and 18 fee waivers at a unit of the Montana university system. The 19 voucher may be presented at the time tuition and fees are 20 paid. The university system may forward the vouchers to the 21 department of military affairs for reimbursament.

22 (3) A member loses his entitlement to the bonus for23 any year in the enlistment if in that year he:

24 (a) loses credit for a drill as a result: of an
25 unexcused absence or unsatisfactory participation as

- 4 (b) does not participate in annual active duty

- 6 (4) Upon loss of entitlement to the bonus, the member

In compliance with a written request received <u>February 1</u>, 1977, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>House Bill 465</u> pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 465 provides an enlistment bonus upon first enlistment in the Montana National Guard.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. There will be approximately 625 persons to take advantage of this option in FY 78 and 520 in FY 79 (necessitating bonus payments for 1,145 personnel in FY 79).
- 2. Of the above, 195 persons each year could be considered directly attributable to the enlistment bonus.
