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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW SCHOOL

DISTRICT VOTED TAX LEVIES TO BE EFFECTIVE FOR 2 YEARS AND

PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE; AMENDING SECTION

7 75-6923, R.C.M. 1947.*

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 75-6923, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

#75-6923. Additional levy for general fund and election for authorization to impose. The trustees of any district may propose to adopt a general fund budget in excess of the general fund budget amount for such district as established by the schedule in section 75-6905 for any of the following purposes:

18 (1) building, altering, repairing, or enlarging any
19 school house of the district:

20 (2) furnishing additional school facilities for the district;

(3) acquisition of land for the district;

23 (4) proper maintenance and operation of the school
24 programs of the district.

25 However, when the trustees adopt a total general fund

budget which exceeds one-hundred-ten-percent-f110% of the
general fund budget for the preceding year, they shall file
a notice of this increase with the superintendent of public
instruction, setting forth the specific reasons for
increasing the budget.

When the trustees of any district determine that an additional amount of financing is required for the general fund budget that is in excess of the statutory schedule amount, the trustees shall submit the proposition of an additional levy to raise such excess amount of general fund financing to the electors who are qualified, under section 75-6410v to vote upon such proposition except that the Twin Bridges high school district may increase its general fund budget as established by section 75-6905y-Rucutu-1947y by the amount of tuition paid to the district the previous year under section 75-6319y-RuEsHs-1947. Such special election shall be called and conducted in the manner prescribed by this title for school elections.
