BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 43-709, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

vacancies. There is hereby created a legislative council which consists of four-(4) gight members of the house of representatives who shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, with the advice of the majority and minority leaders of the house no more than two-(2) four of whom shall be of the same political party, and four-(4) eight members of the state senate who shall be appointed by the committee on committees of the state senate, no more than two-(2) four of whom shall be of the same political party. The committee on committees of the state senate and the speaker of the house of representatives shall prepare their lists of appointees so that the lists of appointees may be subject to confirmation as to the senate members by the

senate and as to the house members by the house of representatives. Membership on the council shall be for two (2) years and terminates with appointment of a new council or on the fiftieth legislative day of the first regular session following the biennium in which the appointment was made, whichever event occurs first. A new council shall be appointed no later than the fiftieth day of each succeeding first regular session. In the event of a failure to appoint council members within the time above stated or in the event 10 of a refusal by either the senate or the house of representatives to confirm appointments on the council, then 11 12 the members on the council from either house in which there 13 is a failure to appoint or confirm shall be elected 14 forthwith by the members of such house. Any vacancy on said 15 legislative council occurring when the legislature is not in session shall be filled by the selection of another member 16 17 by the same method as the original appointment and confirmed 18 by the remaining members of the council."
