In compliance with a written request received <u>January 31</u>, 19, 77, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>House Bill 587</u> pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 587 permits members of the National Guard to file applications to become members of the Public Employees Retirement System and to receive credit for prior service.

ASSUMPTION:

The bill, as written, restricts itself to "prior service" as defined under Section 68-1608 and 68-1502, R.C.M. 1947, which is service before July 1, 1945. Since service prior to July 1, 1945, has been included in the amortization schedule of retirement system, there is no fiscal impact due to this bill.
