8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9 Section 1. Section 4-2-201, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to
10 read as follows:

11 "4-2-201. Reduction for quantity sales of liquor.
12 Reduction of five percent (5%) of the retail price of liquor
13 sold at the state liquor store shall be made by the
14 department for sales of liquor to any person purchasing
15 liquor in unbroken case lots or in an amount greater than
16 \$100 retail sales price, whether cases have been broken or
17 not. No other reduction shall be made by the department of
18 revenue for quantity sales of liquor."

DESCRIPTION

This bill extends the 5% liquor discount to any purchase of more than \$100 worth of liquor.

ASSUMPTIONS

The Department of Revenue is unable to estimate the number of potential sales of liquor which would exceed \$100.

TECHNICAL NOTE

Insufficient data exists on which a determination of the effect of this bill could be based.
