In compliance with a written request received February 8, 19 77, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 623 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to permit the Department of Institutions to purchase clothing items without conforming to bid requirements of Section 82-1917, RCM, 1947.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. There will be an estimated 20 percent increase in procurement costs due to the elimination of competitive bidding on pre-established garment requirements.
2. Since no additional source of revenue is provided it is assumed that the additional cost must be supported by this state general fund.

Section 1. Section 82-1919, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

"82-1919. Purchase of fresh fruits and vegetables -- emergency purchases. (1) Fresh fruits and vegetables (other than potatoes) shall not be included in the supplies to be purchased as provided in this chapter. The department may allow a state agency or institution to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables. An itemized account shall be kept of these purchases and the account shall be furnished to the department.

(2) Likewise, when immediate delivery of articles or performance of service is required by the public exigencies, the articles or service so required may be procured by open purchase or contract at the place and in the manner in which the articles are usually bought and sold or the services engaged between individuals, but under the direction of the

department.

(3) The department of administration may exempt the department of institutions from the provisions of 82-1917 for the purchase of suitable clothing by the department of institutions for residents of juvenile correctional facilities.

(4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "SUITABLE CLOTHING" MEANS STYLED, SEASONABLE CLOTHING, WHICH WILL ALLOW THE RESIDENT TO MAKE A NORMAL APPEARANCE IN THE COMMUNITY."
