Section 2. Scope of energy assistance program. Any 19 20 energy assistance program administered by the department of social and rehabilitation services extends to all forms and 21 22 sources of energy which are used in the home, including but not limited to: 23 (1) electricity; 24

(2) natural gas;

 (4) propane; and
 (5) heating oil.
- Section 3. Rules authorized. The department of social and rehabilitation services is authorized to adopt rules necessary for the administration of any energy assistance program.
