This mandatory procedure applies, where practicable, to all asbestos-lined surfaces. 16 17 (d) When demotition by toppling is performed, a reasonable enclosure for dust emission control must be 18 19 constructed. (e) Adequate wetting to suppress dust must be 20 performed before and during the demolition or toppling. 21 22 (f) Asbestos-containing debris may not be dropped or

(g) During transportation of the debris, it must be thoroughly wetted before loading and must be enclosed or covered during its transport to prevent dust dispersion. (h) The asbestos-containing debris must be buried DEPASITED at a sanitary landfill at which it is unlikely to be disturbed, and signs must be posted around the landfill warning that asbestos-containing debris is buried there. Whenever a fibrated product or compound is applied to a surface utilizing a spray or pneumatic means of application, one person must be assigned full-time supervisory authority for all aspects of the
