Section 1. Municipality — definition. Unless the context requires a different meaning, any reference to "municipality" In the laws governing police retirement and death and disability benefits includes those jurisdictions which, prior to May 2, 1977, were incorporated cities and which after that date become or have become part of a municipal-county consolidated local government.

Section 2. Standardization of terminology. To facilitate the use of common terminology for local government purposes, the code commissioner shall, where appropriate, change all statutory references to comply with the following rules:

- (1) Every reference to "fireman" when referring to a person who extinguishes dangerous fires shall be changed to "firefighter".
 - (2) Every reference to "reserve officer" in the laws

governing police retirement and death and disability
benefits shall be changed to "retired officer".
