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24 25 A BILL POR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT A JOB MARKET SURVEY BE CONDUCTED BEFORE A HER VOCATIONAL EGUCATION COURSE IS ESTABLISHED AND TO ALLON GOVERNING FODIES OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO CONTRACT WITH PRIVATE POSTSECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS; AMENDING SECTION 75-7704, R.C.H. 1947."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Job market survey required — content of survey. (1) Before the governing body of any school district, community college district, or unit of the Bontana university system may establish a course in vocational education as defined in 75-7701, it shall conduct a job market survey of the trade in which the course is proposed. The survey shall be conducted in cooperation with the nearest branch of the employment security division, prospective employers, and any existing advisory groups or vocational area in the county.

(2) The survey shall include an analysis of existing vocational education courses in the trade maintained by high schools, community colleges, and private postsecondary educational institutions in the county.

Section 2. Options in providing vocational education.

After completing the survey required in [section 1 of this act], the governing body of a school district, community college district, or unit of the Montana university system may execute one of the following options based on the results of the survey:

- 7 (1) establish a vocational education course in the 8 trade, in accordance with the standards of the board of 9 public education;
- 10 (2) sign a contract with a private postsecondary
 11 educational institution:
- 12 (3) discontinue plans for establishing a new 13 vocational education course.

Section 3. Contracts with private postsecondary

educational institutions. (1) Each contract between the

governing body of a school district, community college

district, or unit of the Bontana university system and a

private postsecondary educational institution for the

purpose of providing vocational education to students shall:

- (a) be approved by the board of public education:
- 21 (b) provide that the amount charged for each student
 22 enrolled in the course does not exceed the total direct and
 23 indirect costs of providing the same training in the public
 24 school or the tuition the private institution charges its
 25 students, whichever is lower:

(c) provide that public school students receiving vocational education in a private postsecondary educational institution may not be charged additional tuition for any training included in the contract;

education."

- 5 (d) provide that the course must meet standards for 6 vocational education courses established by the board of 7 public education.
 - (2) The board of public education may cause an audit of the accounts of the private postsecondary educational institution and the governing body signing a contract for vocational education to the extent necessary to assure the integrity of the public funds.
- Section 4. Section 75-7704, R.C.B. 1947, is amended to read as follows:
 - #75-7704. District authorization to establish and maintain vocational education courses and programs. After conducting a job market survey as required in [section 1 of this act], the The trustees of any district, community college district, or unit of the Bontana university system may establish and maintain a vocational education course or program that complies with the vocational education standards adopted by the board of <u>public</u> education. In order for a course or program to be eligible for state or federal financing, it shall be approved by the board of <u>public</u>

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 746 requires that a job market survey be conducted before a new vocational education course is established and to allow governing bodies of schools to contract with private postsecondary educational institutions.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. .50 FTE professional staff and .50 FTE secretarial staff and commensurate operating and equipment expenses will be required.
- 2. Increased competition could potentially decrease the cost of delivering vocational education; however, the fiscal magnitude is indeterminable.
