A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING \$25,000

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B BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Public service commission -- expanded 10 studies of energy rates. To complement the work of the 11 consumer counsel in his ongoing study of utility rate 12 structures and demand characteristics the public service 13 commission shall:

(1) conduct a 1-year analysis of the operations of the
major energy utility companies to determine their real costs
of providing electric power and natural gas to all customer
classes;

18 (2) determine whether the existing rate schedules
19 accurately charge just and reasonable rates to customers
20 according to their responsibility for electric service costs
21 incurred for their benefit including the long-run marginal
22 cost and cost of service; and

23 (3) recommend at the conclusion of this study an
24 electric utility rate schedule which more accurately
25 reflects true costs of service and which supports the

1 conservation of deletable energy sources.

Section 2. Rates to be revised after study. (1) Upon the completion of this study. the public service commission is directed to establish rates based on the findings of the study including the costs of service, the long-run incremental costs (marginal costs) of the energy supplied, and other provision in the best interests of the citizens of Montana.

9 (2) These rates may be adjusted to encourage
10 conservation in each customer class and the use of renewable
11 energy resources such as solary wind, and biomass conversion
12 by both customers and utilities.
13 Section 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from

14 the general fund for the biennium ending June 30, 1979, the

15 sum of \$25,000 to the public service commission to carry out

16 the purposes of this act.

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
