BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 72-658, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

*72-658. Right of shipper upon default of railroad company. In case such railroad or railway company shall fail, within twenty-four hours after written complaint has been made by the shipper or his representative, to clean and safely cooper such car or cars, then such shipper or his representative shall have authority to enter upon such car or cars, and properly and safely cooper and clean the same; and said railroad or railway company shall pay for the labor expended in such repairs at the rate of three—dollars £30 per eight-hour day, and the actual cost of material used, providing that such charge shall in no case exceed five dollars \$100 for each car so coopered.**

Section 2. Section 72-662, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to

read as follows:
