HE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Purpose and specifications. It is the purpose of this act to provide funds for the planning and construction of a legislative office auditing south of and connected to the center core of the capitol building. Wherever reasonably possible, the exterior motif of the capitol building should be closely adhered to; the present circular access drive and parking should be preserved and if parking spaces are eliminated, equivalent parking should be provided; the facility should provide office and work areas for lagislators and staff and should include meeting rooms, an assembly auditorium, cafeteria, waiting and hospitality lobby. Tibrary, and other necessary areas; and the facility should be integrably connected to the capitol fullding by means of a corridor on a lasst on lay 1.
