 12 licenses shall be so issued so as to expire December 31 of  
 13 each calendar year. On or before December 31 of each  
 14 calendar year, every firm, person, corporation, association,  
 15 copartnership having a license, shall apply to the state  
 16 department of revenue for a renewal license for the calendar  
 17 year next ensuing. All applications for a renewal shall be  
 18 made upon forms which shall be prescribed and furnished by  
 19 the state department of revenue.

20 Each such application for a renewal license shall be  
 21 accompanied by the license fee as prescribed in sections  
 22 84-2405 and 84-2407.

23 All licenses shall lapse on December 31 of the year for  
 24 which the license was issued, and if, by December 31, an  
 25 application for a renewal license for the calendar year next
