DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 38 accepts the retrocession of such jurisdiction as had been ceded to the United States over the lands within the boundaries of the Big Hole National Battlefield.

ASSUMPTION:

That the State of Montana is accepting concurrent jurisdiction for civil jurisdictional purposes only and not for administrative purposes.

FISCAL IMPACT:

None, provided that the state does not have to maintain or patrol the battlefield.
