If an award or settlement in excess of \$50,000 is granted in any claim against the state or a county, municipality. taxing district, or other political subdivision of the state, the fee of plaintiff's attorney is subject to approval by the court. The court may approve a reasonable fee with due regard to the time spent by the attorney, the complexity of the case, and the skill demonstrated by the attorney in the case.
