### DESCRIPTION

This bill raises the ceiling on the mill levy for cemetery districts from 2 mills to 4 mills.

### ASSUMPTION

> This bill raises the maximum allowable county levy for cemetery levies from 2 to 4 mills. This has no impact on either state revenues or expenditures.

# EFFECT ON LOCAL REVENUES

The impact of this bill depends on whether a particular county decides to increase the levy for cemetery districts beyond 2 mills. It is impossible to anticipate the behavior of every county, therefore, the fiscal impact is impossible to calculate.
