A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REVISE THE METHOD OF BUDGETING FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS OF COUNTY SUPERINTENDENTS OF SCHOOLS; PROVIDING FOR COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT FINANCE BOARDS TO OVERSEE THE BUDGET PROCESS; REPEALING SECTION 75-5804. R.C.E. 1947."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HONTANA:

Section 1. County superintendent finance board — creation — composition. (1) The board of trustees for each elementary and high school district within a county shall by majority vote designate one of their number to serve on the county superintendent finance board for the county.

to the number of members of the finance board shall be equal to the number of elementary and high school districts in the county, except that in no case may the finance board consist of less than three members. Whenever a county has only one district, the trustees for that district shall designate three of their members to serve on the finance board. Whenever a county has only two districts, the trustees of the district having the higher ANB (average number belonging), computed according to Title 75, chapter 69. shall designate two of their members to serve on the

- 1 finance board and the trustees of the district having the
- 2 lower AMB shall designate one such member to so serve.
- 3 Section 2. County superintendent finance board term
- 4 -- vacancy. (1) Each member of the county superintendent
- 5 finance board, after being designated as such pursuant to
- 6 [Section 1], shall serve as a member of that board until the
 - expiration of his term or removal as a trustee of the
- 8 district.
- (2) Whenever a vacancy occurs on the county
- 10 superintendent finance board, it shall be filled in the
- 11 manner provided in [Section 1] after the corresponding
- 12 vacated trustee position has been filled pursuant to
- 13 75-5918.

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- 14 Section 3. County superintendent finance board --
- 15 chairman quorum voting requirements records. (1)
- 16 The county superintendent finance board shall elect a
- 17 chairman from among its members.
- 18 (2) A majority of the board members constitutes a
- 19 quorum, except whenever the board consists of only three
- 20 members in which case all members must be present to
- 21 constitute a quorum.
- 22 (3) An action of the board requires a majority vote of
- 23 those present at a meeting at which there is a quorum.
 - (4) The board shall keep a record of its proceedings.
- 25 Section 4. Travel reimbursement of members of county

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superintendent finance board. Hembers of the county
superintendent finance board shall be reimbursed for travel
expenses as provided in 75-5931.

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- Section 5. Preparation of county superintendent administrative budget. The county superintendent shall prepare a budget within the limitations of [Section 8] for the administrative costs incident to the carrying out of his duties, including staff, office space, supplies, and other reasonable expenses for the ensuing school fiscal year.
- Section 6. Staff appointments. Subject to the approval
 of the county superintendent finance board, the county
 superintendent may appoint and fix the salaries of his
 deputies, assistants, and other staff personnel.
 - Section 7. Supervision of budget preparation. The county superintendent finance board shall generally supervise the preparation by the county superintendent of his administrative budget. The board may require the county superintendent to provide it with such information or documents as it considers necessary to the carrying out of its general supervisory duty.
- 21 Section 8. Maximum budget for county superintendent
 22 administrative costs. (1) Subject to subsection (2), the
 23 maximum administrative budget for a county superintendent's
 24 office shall be determined by multiplying the total county
 25 AMB (average number belonging), computed in the manner

provided in Title 75, chapter 69, for all of the elementary and high school districts in the county by the dollars per ANB for the class to which the county belongs according to the following schedule:

5	Class	Total County ANB	Dollars Per ANB
6	1	over 15,000	\$ 8
7	2	8,000 - 14,999	10
8	3	2,000 - 7,999	12
9	4	1,000 - 1,999	20
10	5	under 1,000	25

- 11 (2) The county superintendent finance board may, in 12 its discretion, approve an additional amount of up to 10% of 13 the budget calculated according to subsection (1).
- 14 Section 9. Notice of meeting of county superintendent 15 finance board. During the month of June, the county 16 superintendent shall publish a notice at least one time in a 17 newspaper of general circulation in the county stating that 18 the county superintendent finance board will meet on the 19 second Nonday in July to consider the county superintendent 20 administrative budget. The notice shall also state the place 21 and hour at which the meeting will be held.
- Section 10. Meeting of county superintendent finance
 board. (1) The county superintendent finance board shall
 the second Monday in July to consider the
 administrative budget submitted by the county

- superintendent.
- 2 (2) Within the limitations of [Section 8], the board
 3 may approve the budget as submitted by the county
- 4 superintendent or may make any changes or corrections it
- 5 considers necessary.
- 6 (3) Any taxpayer in the county may attend the meeting
 7 and be heard on the budget.
- 8 Section 11. Submission of approved county
- 9 superintendent administrative budget to county commissioners
- 10 tax levy. On the second Honday in August when the board
- 11 of county commissioners meets for the purpose of fixing tax
- 12 levies, the county superintendent shall place before the
- 13 commissioners his administrative budget as approved by the
- 14 county superintendent finance board.
- 15 (2) The board of county commissioners shall fix and
- 16 levy on the taxable value of all the property in the county
- 17 the number of mills required to finance the county
- 18 superintendent administrative budget as approved by the
- 19 county superintendent finance board.
- 20 Section 12. Repealer. Section 75-5804, R.C.M. 1947, is
- 21 repealed.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act revising the method of budgeting for administrative costs of county superintendents of schools, and providing for county superintendent finance boards to oversee the budget process.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Administrative costs of county superintendents of schools will increase 6% per year.
- 2. Administrative costs will be budgeted at the maximum allowed each year of the 1979 biennium (includes the additional 10% allowance).
- 3. ANB by county will remain the same as in FY 77.
- 4. The proposed finance boards will consist of a total of 627 members who must travel a one-way distance of ten (10) miles (total twenty (20) miles) to attend each meeting. Finance boards will meet one time each year.

TECHNICAL NOTE:

Calculations made while prepairing this fiscal note reveal that the rate schedule as proposed provides, in certain instances, a higher maximum budget for counties with a lower ANB. For example, Big Horn County, with an ANB of 2,518, is provided a maximum budget of S33,238. Beaverhead County, with an ANB of 1,815, is provided a maximum budget of S39,930.
