In compliance with a written request received January 17, 19 77, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate Bill 106 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 106 proposes transferring a portion of the Montana State Fair Grounds from the Department of Administration to Lewis and Clark County.

ASSUMPTIONS:

The Montana State Fair Grounds have been leased to Lewis and Clark County since 27 March, 1958. The lease extends to the year 2008 for the cost of one dollar (\$1.00).

FISCAL IMPACT:

No fiscal impact is identifiable.

TECHNICAL NOTE:

The act provides for the transfer by the Department of Administration, which is the custodian of the land; however, only the State Land Board is authorized to dispose of state lands.
