BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 4-4-406, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

"4-4-406. City and county licenses -- fees. The city council of any incorporated town or city or the county commissioners outside of any incorporated town or city may provide for the issuance of licenses to persons to whom a retail license has been issued under the provisions of this code, and may fix license fees thereof, not to exceed a sum equal to ~~fifty-per-cent-(50%)~~ ~~five-eighths~~ of the license fee for an all-beverage license or 100% of the fee for a beer or beer-and-wine license collected by the department from such licensee under this code."

FISCAL NOTE

In compliance with a written request received February 8, 19 77, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate Bill 107 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION

This bill increases fees which local governments may charge the holder of a license under the alcoholic beverage code to the level of such fees prior to 1975.

ASSUMPTIONS

This bill only applies to fees that local governments may charge for licensed liquor and beer establishments. Therefore, there is no fiscal impact.

EFFECT ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT REVENUES

Local government revenues would increase depending on the amount of liquor and beer licenses in the city or county. Below is an example of the effect in the city of Helena.

Under current law:

$$\text{Revenue collected} = \frac{1}{2}(37 \times 800) + \frac{1}{2}(4 \times 200) + \frac{1}{2}(10 \times 400) = \$17,200$$

Liquor beer beer&wine

Under proposed law:

$$\text{Revenue collected} = .625(37 \times 800) + 1(4 \times 200) + 1(10 \times 400) = \$23,300$$

The increase to the city of Helena would be: \$6,100.
