DESCRIPTION

This bill increases fees which local governments may charge the holder of a license under the alcoholic beverage code to the level of such fees prior to 1975.

ASSUMPTIONS

This bill only applies to fees that local governments may charge for licensed liquor and beer establishments. Therefore, there is no fiscal impact.

EFFECT ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT REVENUES

Local government revenues would increase depending on the amount of liquor and beer licens in the city or county. Below is an example of the effect in the city of Helena.

Under current law:

Revenue collected = $\frac{1}{2}(37x800) + \frac{1}{2}(4x200) + \frac{1}{2}(10x400) = $17,200$ Liquor beer beer&wine

Under proposed law:

Revenue collected = .625(37x800) + 1(4x200) + 1(10x400) = \$23,300

The increase to the city of Helena would >: \$6,100.
