12BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:13Section 1. Section 37-105, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to

14 read as follows:

15 "37-105. Benefit eligibility conditions. An unemployed 16 individual shall be eligible to receive benefits for any 17 week of total unemployment within his benefit year; only if 18 the division finds that -- the following conditions have 19 been met:

20 (a) He has registered for work at and thereafter has 21 continued to report at an employment office in accordance 22 with such regulation as the division may prescribe, except 23 that the division may, by regulation, prescribe that such 24 types of cases or situations with respect to which it finds 25 that compliance with such requirements would be oppressive, or would be inconsistent with the purposes of this act,
 provide for registration and reporting for work by mail or
 through other governmental agencies.

4 (b) He has made a claim for benefits in accordance
5 with the provisions of section 87-107(a).

(c) He is able to work and is available for work and 5 7 is seeking work, provided, however, that no claimant shall be considered ineligible in any week of unemployment for 8 failure to comply with the provisions of this subsection if 9 such failure is due to an illness or disability which occurs 10 11 after he has registered for work and no suitable work has 12 been offered to such claimant after the beginning of such 13 illness or disability.

14 (d) Prior to any week for which he claims benefits he 15 has been totally unemployed for a waiting period of one (1) week. However, if claimant's benefit year expires during a 16 17 period of compensable unemployment, claimant will continue to receive weekly benefits, in a new benefit year, if 13 19 otherwise eligible, without interruption to serve the waiting week for the new benefit year, but will thereafter 20 be required to serve the waiting week before receiving 21 22 benefits during subsequent unemployment in the new benefit year. No week shall be counted as a week of total 23 24 unemployment for the purposes of this subsection:

7 (e) An individual who received penefits during a 8 benefit year must perform services for remuneration after 9 the beginning of that year as a condition for receiving 10 benefits in a second benefit year. The service may be in 11 either covered or noncovered employment, however, the 12 individual must have earned the lesser of three-thirteenths (3/13) of his high quarter of his second benefit year or six 13 14 (6) times his weekly benefit amount of that same year.

(f) Benefits based on service in employment defined in 15 section 87-148 (j)(6) and (7) and-section-07-110-(d) shall 16 17 be payable in the same amount, on the same terms and subject 18 to the same conditions as compensation payable on the pasis of other service subject to this act; except that benefits 19 20 based on service in an-instructionaly-researchy-or-principal 21 administrative-capacity-in a public school of the state of 22 Montana, or in an institution of higher education (as defined in section 87-148 (n)) shall not be paid to an 23 individual for any week of unemployment which begins during 24 25 the period between two successive academic years, or during 1 a similar period between two regular terms, whether or not 2 successive, or during a period of paid sabbatical leave 3 provided for in the individual's contract, if the individual 4 has a contract or contracts to perform services in any such 5 capacity for any such public school, institution, or 6 institutions of higher education for both such academic 7 years or both such terms.^m

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act which provides that unemployment benefits based upon service in a public school shall not be paid to any individual for any week of unemployment during the period between two successive academic years or two regular terms if such individual has a contract to perform services for any such public school for both such years or terms.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed legislation does not produce any additional revenue for the Unemployment Trust Fund nor does it have any significant effect upon the amount of unemployment insurance benefits paid from that fund.
