All revenue from this property tax levy shall be appropriated for the support, maintenance, and improvement of the Montana university system and other public educational institutions subject to board of regents supervision. The board of regents may, at its discretion, allocate up to one-half of the mill levy authorized by the legislature from the community college districts in which the community colleges

are located for the support and maintenance of the community college districts. Section 2. Submission to electorate. The question 3 whether this act will become effective shall be submitted to the electors of the state of Montana at the general election to be held November 7, 1978, by printing on the ballot the full title of this act, and the following: FOR the 6-mill levy for the support of public educational institutions subject to board of regents' 10 supervision. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

This bill is an act to continue the funding of public educational institutions subject to Board of Regents' supervision by a levy of not to exceed 6 mills on all taxable property each year for 10 years and providing that the proposed act be submitted to the electors of the state of Montana.

ASSUMPTION

Since the revenue which is generated by the 6 mill levy will be appropriated by this session for the use of the University System during the 1978-79 blannium, the proposed legislation will have no effect during this blennium.

FISCAL IMPACT

No effect during this biennium.

EFFECT ON LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

No effect on local governments.

LONG-RANGE EFFECTS

If this bill were enacted and the measure subsequently received a negative vote in the 1978 election, the 1979 legislature would have to look to other sources of revenue upon which to draw in order to fund the University System.
