 15 sources for purposes of public education in those districts
 16 which do not employ a district superintendent.

17 (2) Subject to applicable federal and state guidelines
 18 and, in the case of moneys received from private sources,
 19 subject to any guidelines fixed by the donor, a county
 20 superintendent may, in his discretion, disburse moneys
 21 received under this section to one or more of the public
 22 elementary and high school districts, which do not employ a
 23 district superintendent, according to their needs. The
 24 county superintendent shall supervise the utilization of
 25 such moneys by the district or districts to the extent

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENTS OF SCHOOLS TO REQUEST, ACCEPT, AND DISPURSE MONEYS AVAILABLE FROM FEDERAL, STATE, AND PRIVATE SOURCES FOR PURPOSES OF PUBLIC EDUCATION IN THOSE DISTRICTS WHICH DO NOT EMPLOY A DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. County superintendent authorized to request, accept, and disburse federal, state, and private moneys. (1) A county superintendent may, WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE APPROPRIATE SCHOOL BOARDS, request and accept moneys made available from federal, state, or private sources for purposes of public education in those districts which do not employ a district superintendent.

(2) Subject to applicable federal and state guidelines and, in the case of moneys received from private sources, subject to any guidelines fixed by the donor, a county superintendent may, in his discretion, disburse moneys received under this section to one or more of the public elementary and high school districts, which do not employ a district superintendent, according to their needs. The county superintendent shall supervise the utilization of

~~such moneys by the district or districts to the extent necessary to insure that any such guidelines are followed WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE APPROPRIATE SCHOOL BOARDS.~~

(3) The county superintendent may establish a fund, for which the county treasurer shall maintain a separate accounting, for the deposit of moneys received under this section.
