 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION  
 5 69-3605, R.C.M. 1947, TO CLARIFY THE DEFINITION OF "PATIENT"  
 6 WITH REGARD TO THE OPERATION OF AMBULANCE SERVICES."

 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 69-3605, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to  
 10 read as follows:

11 "69-3605. Definitions. Unless the context requires  
 12 otherwise, in this act: (1) "Ambulance" means a privately or  
 13 publicly owned motor vehicle that is especially designed,  
 14 constructed, and equipped, which is maintained and used for  
 15 the transportation of patients, including dual purpose  
 16 police patrol cars and funeral coaches or hearses which  
 17 otherwise comply with this act, but does not include a motor  
 18 vehicle owned by, or operated under the direct control of  
 19 the United States or this state of Montana.

20 (2) "Ambulance service" means a person who operates an  
 21 ambulance.

22 (3) "Attendant" means a trained or otherwise qualified  
 23 individual responsible for the operation of an ambulance and  
 24 the care of the patients whether or not the attendant also  
 25 serves as driver.

1 (4) "Attendant-driver" means a person who is qualified  
 2 as an attendant and a driver.

3 (5) "Driver" means an individual who drives an  
 4 ambulance.

5 (6) "Dual purpose police patrol car" means a vehicle,  
 6 operated by a police department, which is equipped as an  
 7 ambulance, even though it is also used for patrol or other  
 8 police purposes.

9 (7) "Department" means the department of health and  
 10 environmental sciences, provided for in Title 82A, chapter  
 11 6.

12 (8) "Board" means the board of health and  
 13 environmental sciences, provided for in section 82A-605.

14 (9) "Patient" means an individual who is sick,  
 15 injured, wounded, or otherwise incapacitated or helpless but  
 16 does not include persons in wheelchairs merely because they  
 17 are nonambulatory.

18 (10) "Person" means an individual, firm, partnership,  
 19 association, corporation, company, group of individuals  
 20 acting together for a common purpose, or organization of any  
 21 kind, including a governmental agency other than the United  
 22 States or this state."

(10) "Person" means an individual, firm, partnership, association, corporation, company, group of individuals acting together for a common purpose, or organization of any kind, including a governmental agency other than the United States or this state."
