4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE
 5 GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY TO FIX THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN
 6 COUNTY OFFICERS; AMENDING SECTION 25-605, R.C.M. 1947."

 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 9 Section 1. Section 25-605, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to
 10 read as follows:

11 "25-605. Salaries of certain county officers. The
 12 salaries of county treasurers, clerk and recorder, clerk of
 13 the court, county attorneys, sheriffs, county
 14 superintendents of schools, and of county surveyors in
 15 counties where county surveyors now receive salaries as
 16 provided in section 16-3302, shall be based ~~on the~~
 17 ~~population and taxable valuation of the county in accordance~~
 18 ~~with the following schedule:~~ fixed by the governing body of
 19 the county, subject to the restriction that a governing body
 20 may not reduce any salary for an office below the level
 21 effective on July 1, 1977.

4 The total salary paid to county treasurers, clerk and
5 recorder, clerk of the court, county attorneys, sheriffs,
6 county superintendents of schools and county sheriffs, and
7 county surveyors in counties where county surveyors receive
8 salaries, as provided in section 16-3302, shall be the sum
9 of the salary shown in column A based on population when
10 added to the salary shown in column B based on taxable
11 valuation, provided, however, that county superintendent of
12 schools shall receive in addition to the salary based upon
13 the totals of columns A and B above the sum of four hundred
14 dollars (\$400) per year and county sheriffs and county
15 attorneys shall receive in addition to the salary based
16 upon the totals of columns A and B above the sum of one
17 thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200) per year.
18 Notwithstanding the above, in each county with a population
19 in excess of thirty thousand (30,000) the salary of the
20 county attorney shall be twenty-five thousand dollars
21 (\$25,000) per year."
