DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 197 provides for the election rather than the apointment of members to the Wheat Research and Marketing Committee and changes the name of the Committee to the Grain Research and Marketing Committee.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Election costs will be financed from the Wheat Research and Marketing Committee's Federal and Private Revenue Account.
- 2. Board of election supervisors will consist of five (5) members.
 - (a) Member will receive \$26 per diem per meeting for two (2) meetings per year.
 - (b) Member will be reimbursed for travel. The average round trip is 400 miles at \$0.15 per mile.
