DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to exempt teachers at state institutions from the state classification and pay plan.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- If passed, teachers would negotiate a salary scale which approximates the rate paid by the school district in which the institution resides.
- 2. There are 60 teachers in state institutions affected by this bill.
- 3. Salaries under existing law will be funded as recommended in the Executive Budget.
- 4. All other laws regarding employee benefits of teachers will remain the same (vacation, insurance, sick leave).
- 5. Although some teachers are 12 month teachers, only the increased costs of the 9 month school term was considered.
- 6. School district salaries will increase 2.35% from FY78 to FY79.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Based on current school district salary schedules and present incumbents, the increased costs to the state would be:
