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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: MAN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT NEWLY ELECTED SCHOOL DISTRICT TRUSTEES TAKE DEFICE ON THE FIRST SATURDAY IN JULY: AMENDING SECTIONS 75-5916 AND 75-5927, R.C.M. 1947."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 75-5916, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

*75-5916. Qualification and oath. Any person who receives a certificate of election as a trustee under the provisions of section 75-6423 shall may not assume the trustee position until he has qualified. Such person shall qualify by completing and filing an oath of office with the county superintendent not-more-than-fifteen-(15)-days--efter the -- receipt-of-the-certificate-of-election before the first Saturday in July in the year of his election. After a person has qualified for a trustee position, he shall hold such position for until the expiration of the term of the position, as provided in 75-5927, and until his successor has been elected or appointed and has been qualified.

If the elected person does not qualify in accordance 24 with this requirement, a person shall be appointed in the

manner provided by section 75-5918 and shall serve until the next regular election."

Section 2. Section 75-5927, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 3 read as follows:

#75-5927. Organization and officers. (1) The trustees of each district shall annually organize as a governing board of the district after-the--regular--election--day--and ofter-the-issuance-of-the-election-certificates-to-the-newly elected--trustees--but--not-later-than-the-third-Saturday-of 10 *pril on the first Saturday in July: at which time newly elected trustees shall take office. A trustee's term which 11 12 is set to expire in a particular year expires on the first 13 Saturday in July of that year.

121 In order to organize, the trustees of the district shall be given notice of the time and place where the organization meeting will be held and, at such meeting, they shall choose one of their number as the chairman. In addition, except for the trustees of a high school district operating a county high school, the trustees shall employ and appoint a competent person, who is not a member of the trustees, as the clerk of the district. The trustees of a high school district operating a county high school shall appoint a secretary, who shall be a member of the board.

13) The chairman of the trustees of any district shall serve until the next organization meeting and shall preside

- 2 customary rules of order. He shall perform the duties
- 3 prescribed by this title and any other duties that normally
- 4 pertain to such officer."
