BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. There is a new R.C.M. section numbered 81-407.1 that reads as follows:

81-407.1. Uniform lease renewal. Notwithstanding any other section in this chapter, the department may, in order to achieve uniformity in the number of lease renewals per year, issue 4-, 5-, and 6-year grazing and agricultural leases during the 5-year period 1979-1983. Leases to be issued for other than 10-year terms shall be chosen by means of a nondiscretionary, random process and shall be limited to those leases which were not subject to competitive bid at the previous renewal.

Section 2. Termination date. This act terminates on July 1, 1983.
