4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION  
 5 69-6508, R.C.M. 1947, TO CHANGE THE METHOD OF FILLING  
 6 VACANCIES ON THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COUNCIL."

7  
 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 69-6508, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to  
 10 read as follows:

11 "69-6508. Environmental quality council. The  
 12 environmental quality council shall consist of thirteen (13)  
 13 members to be as follows:

14 (a) The governor or his designated representative  
 15 shall be an ex officio member of the council and shall  
 16 participate in council meetings as a nonvoting member.

17 (b) Four (4) members of the senate and four (4)  
 18 members of the house of representatives appointed before the  
 19 fiftieth legislative day in the same manner as standing  
 20 committees of the respective houses are appointed. A vacancy  
 21 on the council occurring when the legislature is not in  
 22 session shall be filled by the selection of a member of the  
 23 legislature by the ~~remaining members of the council~~ same  
 24 method as the original appointment. No more than two (2) of  
 25 the appointees of each house shall be members of the same

1 political party.

2 (c) Four (4) members of the general public; two (2)  
 3 public members shall be appointed by the speaker of the  
 4 house with the consent of the house minority leader, and two  
 5 (2) shall be appointed by the president of the senate with  
 6 the consent of the senate minority leader.

7 In considering the appointments of (b) and (c) above,  
 8 consideration shall be given to their qualifications to  
 9 analyze and interpret environmental trends and information  
 10 of all kinds; to appraise programs and activities of the  
 11 state government in the light of the policy set forth in  
 12 section 69-6503 of this act; to be conscious and responsive  
 13 to the scientific, economic, social, aesthetic, and cultural  
 14 needs and interests of the state; and to formulate and  
 15 recommend state policies to promote the improvement of the  
 16 quality of the environment."
