10	Section 1. Section 53-122, R.C.N. 1947, is amended to

14	exempt from license or registration fees license or

16	and tractors providing for disposition of all fees.
17	Remistration or license fees shall be paid upon registration

- 11 Tractors, as specified in this section, shall mean any 12 motor vehicle, except passenger cars used for towing a 13 trailer or semitrailer.
 - If any dealer, or motor vehicle, house trailer, trailer, or semitrailer is originally registered six (6) months after the time of registration as set by law, the registration or license fee for the remainder of such year shall be one-half (1/2) of the regular fee above given.
 - A dealer in motor vehicles or trailers who shall maintain more than one (1) place of business or who shall maintain any branch establishment or establishments, must register and pay a registration or license fee for each such place of business or establishment.
- A registered dealer, who may sell or dispose of his entire business to any other person, may have his

- certificate of registration transferred to such purchaser 1 2 upon filing with the registrar of motor vehicles a statement containing the name of the registered dealer, the number under which such dealer is registered, the name of the nurchaser, and the location of the place of business so sold. Upon the filing of such statement, accompanied by 3 filing fee of two dollars (\$2.00), the registrar of motor 7 vehicles shall note upon the registration record of such R 9 dealer the change of ownership. But no certificate of 10 registration can be transferred unless the entire business of the dealer holding such certificate of registration be 11 12 sold and disposed of, and no such certificate of 13 registration can be transferred to any person other than the 14 purchasers of such business.
 - The provisions of this act with respect to the payment of registration fees shall not apply to or be binding upon motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers or tractors owned or controlled by the United States of America or any state, county or city, but in all other respects the provisions of this act shall be applicable to and binding upon motor vehicles, tractors, trailers, and semitrailers.

If an owner or operator of a motor vehicle, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer elects to transfer the license plate from a motor vehicle, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer to a newly acquired motor vehicle, tractor, trailer, or

1	semitrailer, as otherwise permitted by law, such owner or
2	operator shall pay only such portion of the registration
3	fees required by this section as follows:
4	(a) If the registration period for which the license
5	plate to be transferred was last acquired has more than 6
6	months before expiration, no registration fee is required.
7	(b) If the registration period for which the license
8	plate to be transferred was last acquired has 6 months or
9	less before expiration, one-half of such registration fee is

11	Upon reregistration of any such motor vehicle, tractor,
12	trailer, or semitrailer, all fees required by this section

14	All fees, other than license fees, unless otherwise

An act to reduce registration fees for motor vehicles when license plates are transferred from one vehicle to another at the time of registration.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. 90% of all people applying for a new title or title transfer will trade a vehicle that has a current registration receipt.
- 2. The purchase of motor vehicles is assumed to be evenly spread throughout the year.
- 3. The number of titles issued will increase 4.8% a year.
