DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 330 regards the appointment of the Workers' Compensation Judge and authorizes the same salary level for the position as that of the Administrator of the Workers' Compensation Division.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Incumbent will be paid the rate of Grade 20, Step 2 in FY 78 and Grade 20, Step 3 in FY 79. This is in accordance with the provisions in this bill.
- 2. The salary of a District Judge will remain at \$25,000 a year.
- 3. There will be no increase in the salary of District Court Judges.
