A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 94-6-104, R.C.M. 1947, TO INCLUDE THE DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY BY FIRE OR EXPLOSIVES WITH THE PURPOSE TO DEFRAUD AN INSURER IN THE DEFINITION OF ARSON."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 94-6-104, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

"94-6-104. Arson. (1) A person commits the offense of arson when, by means of fire or explosives, he knowingly or purposely:

(a) damages or destroys an occupied structure which is property of another without consent; or

(b) places another person in danger of death or bodily injury; or

(c) damages or destroys any property with the purpose to defraud an insurer.

(2) A person convicted of the offense of arson shall be imprisoned in the state prison for any term not to exceed twenty (20) years."
