10 Section 1. Section 69-5601, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to

12 **69-5601. Definitions. As used in this chapter, unless
13 the context clearly indicates otherwise:

- (1) "Tourist campground" means a place used for public camping primarily by automobile tourists where persons can camp or secure tents or park individual trailers or truck trailers for camping and sleeping purposes.
- (2) "Trailer court" means a parcel of land which may be sold; rented; leased; otherwise conveyed; offered to the public; or offered as a benefit in return for services performed or to be performed and usually designated a trailer court; trailer park or mobile home park upon which two {2} or more spaces are occupied or intended for occupancy by trailers or mobile homes for nonrecreational dwelling purposes.

1 (3) "Board" means the state board of health and 2 environmental sciences.

3 (4) "Department" means the state department of health
4 and environmental sciences.

5 (5) **person** includes an individual, partnership,
6 corporation, association, or other entity engaged in the
7 business of operating or owning or offering the services of
8 a tourist campground or trailer court.**
