9 Section 1. Function transferred to the department. (1)
 10 The function of the auditor of operating the uniform state
 11 central payroll system for all state agencies, created in
 12 25-507.1 through 25-507.5, 25-507.8, 25-507.9, and
 13 25-507.10, are transferred to the department of
 14 administration.

15 (2) Wherever the words "auditor" or "state auditor"
 16 appear in 25-507.1, 25-507.3, 25-507.4, 25-507.5, 25-507.8,
 17 and 25-507.10, the words "department of administration"
 18 shall be substituted therefor.



DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION :

An act transferring the state central payroll system from the state Auditor's Office to the Department of Administration.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This proposal relates only to a transfer of duties and responsibilities. If the budget proposed for administration of the State Central Payroll Program in the State Auditor's submitted budget is appropriated and such appropriation is transferred to the Department of Administration no additional cost will be incurred with the passage of this bill.
