10 Section 1. Section 95-2220, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to
 11 read as follows:

12 "95-2220. Application for participation in furlough
 13 program. Any A prisoner confined in the state prison may
 14 make an application to participate in the furlough program
 15 ~~at least by the time the inmate has served one-half (1/2) of~~
 16 ~~the time--required-to-be-considered-for-parole if:~~

17 (1) the prisoner will be eligible for parole within 1
 18 year after the date of the application; and

19 (2) the prisoner has, in the opinion of the warden,
 20 conformed exceptionally well to prison routine and has shown
 21 promise of performing well in the community."


