The claims investigator is responsible to the attorney general for the investigation of violations of 14 15 87-145 by claimants or employing units or officers or agents of employing units. The employment security division shall 16 17 provide office space for the claims investigator and any other necessary staff to assist the investigator. 18

19 Section 2. Attorney general to be notified of claim 20 settlements. No sums may be repaid to the division of 21 employment security, either directly or by offset of future 22 benefits pursuant to 87-145, without the division having 23 first notified the claims investigator of such violation and 24 of the pending settlement.

3. Federal funds that currently fund these positions will no longer be available; therefore the General Fund will have to fund the positions.
