DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to provide that a highway patrolman receive regular duty pay while responding to a subpoena in a civil or criminal cause when called in connection with his official patrol duties, and that the Department of Justice may bill the person issuing the subpoena for reimbursement for the patrolman's time.

ASSUMPTIONS:

The Department of Justice will continue to bill the person issuing the subpoena for reimbursement for the patrolman's time.
