BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Withholding of construction costs. (1) A bank, savings and loan association, or other lending agency lending money in the state on the construction of a new residence shall withhold from the general contractor constructing the residence 5% of the total construction cost for a period of 1 year. The balance shall be paid at the end of the 1-year period or when all warranty work has been performed or settlement has been reached on warranty claims arising within the 1-year period, whichever occurs later.

- (2) Subsection (1) does not apply when:
- (a) the person building the residence is the owner thereof:
- 23 (b) the general contractor posts a bond with the lending institution in the amount of 5% of the total 25 construction cost conditioned upon the faithful performance

1 of required warranty service.

(3) The lending institution shall pay interest at a 3 rate of 5 1/2% to the contractor on all money withheld under subsection (1).

(4) The provisions of subsection (1) may not be waived by agreement between the contractor and the homeowner or 7 lending institution.
