9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MUNTANA:
10	Section 1. Section 23-2-512, MCA, is amended to read:
11	<pre>#23-2-512. Identification number. (1) The owner of</pre>
12	each motorboat requiring numbering by this state shall file
13	an application for number in the office of the county
14	treasurer where the motorboat is owned or taxable on forms
15	prepared and furnished by the division of motor vehicles.
16	The application shall be signed by the owner of the
17	motorboat and shall be accompanied by a fee of \$1 \$5. Any
18	alteration; change; or false statement contained in the
19	application will render the certificate of number void. Upon
20	receipt of the application in approved form, the county
21	treasurer shall issue to the applicant a certificate of
22	number prepared and furnished by the division of motor
23	vehicles, stating the number awarded to the motorboat and
24	the name and address of the owner.

25 (2) Before filing the application with the county

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1 treasurer, the applicant shall submit it to the county 2 assessor, who shall enter on the application, in a space to 3 be provided for that purpose, the market value and taxable 4 value of the motorboat for the year for which the 5 application for registration is made.

6 (3) The applicant, upon the filing of the application, 7 shall pay to the county treasurer the registration fee and 8 the personal property taxes assessed against the motorboat 9 or vessel for the current year of registration before the 10 application for registration or reregistration may be 11 accepted by the county treasurer.

12 (4) Should the ownership of a motorboat change, a new 13 application form with fee shall be filed within a reasonable 14 time with the county treasurer and a new certificate of 15 number awarded in the same manner as provided for in an 16 original award of number.

17 (5) If an agency of the United States government has 18 in force a comprehensive system of identification numbering 19 for motorboats in the United States, the numbering system 20 employed pursuant to this part by the division of motor 21 vehicles shall be in conformity.

22 (6) Every certificate of number and the license decais
23 awarded under this part shall continue in effect for a
24 period not to exceed 1 year unless sooner terminated or
25 discontinued in accordance with the provisions of this part.

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Certificates of number and license decals shall show the 1 date of expiration and may be renewed by the owner in the 2 3 same manner provided for in the initial securing of the certificate. 4

5 (7) Certificates of pumber shall expire on April 30 of 6 each year and may not be in effect unless renewed under this 7 part.

8 (8) In event of transfer of ownership, the purchaser 9 shall furnish the county treasurer notice within a 10 reasonable time of the acquisition of all or any part of his 11 interest, other than the creation of a security interest, in 12 a motorboat numbered in this state or of the loss, theft, 13 destruction: or abandonment of the motorboat. The transfer: 14 loss, theft, destruction, or abandonment terminates the 15 certificate of number for the motorboat. Recovery from theft 16 or transfer of a part interest that does not affect the 17 owner's right to operate the motorboat does not terminate 18 the certificate of number.

19 (9) A holder of a certificate of number shall notify 20 the county treasurer within reasonable time if his address 21 no longer conforms to the address appearing on the 22 certificate and furnish the county treasurer with his new 23 address. The division of motor vehicles may provide by rule 24 for the surrender of the certificate bearing the former 25 address and its replacement with a certificate bearing the

3 new address or the alteration of an outstanding certificate 2 to show the new address of the holder.

3 (10) (a) The number awarded must be painted on or 4 attached to each outboard side of the forward half of the 5 motorboat or, if there are no such sides, at a corresponding location on both outboard sides of the foredeck of the 6 7 motorboat. The number awarded shall read from left to right. 8 be in Arebic numbrals, in block characters of good proportion at least 3 .nches tall excluding border or trime 9 10 of a color that contrasts with the color of the background, 11 and be so maintained as to be clearly visible and legible. 12 The number may not be placed on the obscured underside of 13 the flared bow where it cannot be easily seen from another 14 vessel or ashore. No numerals, letters, or devices, other 15 than those used in connection with the identifying number 16 issued, may be placed in the proximity of the identifying 17 number. No numerals, letters, or devices which might 18 interfere with the ready identification of the motorboat by 19 its identifying number may be carried as to interfere with 20 the motorboat's identification. No number other than the 21 number and license decal awarded to a motorboat or granted 22 reciprocity under this part shall be painted, attached, or otherwise displayed on either side of the forward half of 23 24 the motorboat.

(b) The certificate of number shall be pocket size and

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available to federal, state, or local law enforcement officers at all reasonable times for inspection on the motorboat whenever the motorboat is on waters of this state. (c) Boat liveries are not required to have the certificate of number on board each motorboat, but a rental agreement must be carried on board livery motorboats in place of the certificate of number.

8 (11) Fees collected under this section shall be 9 transmitted to the state treasurer who shall deposit the 10 fees in the motorboat certificate identification account of an earmarked revenue fund. These fees shall be used only for 11 12 the administration and enforcement of this part, as amended. (12) An owner of a motorboat must within a reasonable 13 time notify the division of motor vehicles, giving the 14 motorboat's identifying number and the owner's name when 15 that motorboat becomes documented as a vessel of the United 16 17 States or is transferred, lost, destroyed, abandoned, or frauded or within 60 days after change of state of principal 18 19 use."
