A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO INCREASE REVENUE FROM STATE FISHING LICENSES BY INCREASING THE FISHING LICENSE FEES AND ESTABLISHING A SEPARATE MONRESIDENT WILDLIFE CONSERVATION FEE; AMENDING SECTIONS 87-2-202 AND 87-2-301 THROUGH 87-2-304 MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 87-2-202, MCA, is amended to read:

#87-2-202. Application -- stamp attachment -- fee -expiration. (1) A wildlife conservation license shall be
sold upon written application. The application shall
contain the applicant's name, age, occupation, place of
residence, post-office address, and length of time in the
state of Montana; state whether the applicant is a citizen
of the United States or an alien; and be subscribed by the
applicant. The applicant shall present a driver's license or
other identification to substantiate the information.

(2) Hunting, fishing, or trapping licenses in the form of tags or stamps issued to a holder of a wildlife conservation license must be affixed to or recorded on the

wildlife conservation license according to such rules as the department may prescribe.

- (3) Resident and—monresident wildlife conservation licenses may be purchased for a fee of \$1. Nonresident wildlife conservation licenses may be purchased for a fee of \$2.
- (4) Licenses issued shall be void after April 30 next
 succeeding their issuance.

10 "87-2-301. Class A--resident fishing license. Any
11 resident, as defined by 87-2-102, upon payment of a fee of
12 65 17.50, shall receive a Class A license which shall
13 entitle the holder thereof to fish with hook and line or rod
14 as authorized by regulations of the department."

Section 3. Section 87-2-302. MCA, is amended to read:

"87-2-302. Class b--nonresident fishing license. Any
person not a resident, as defined in 87-2-102, upon payment
of the sum of \$28 \$32 to any agent of the department
authorized to issue fishing and hunting licenses, shall be
entitled to a Class 8 license which shall entitle the holder
thereof to fish with book and line as authorized by the
rules and regulations of the department."

23 Section 4. Section 87-2-303, MCA, is amended to read: 24 "87-2-303. Class B-3--temporary nonresident or tourist 25 fishing license. Any person not a resident, as defined in

- 1 87-2-102, upon payment of the sum of \$15 to any agent of
 2 the department authorized to issue fishing and hunting
 3 licenses, shall be entitled to a temporary nonresident
 4 fishing license which shall authorize the holder to fish
 5 with hook and line as authorized by the rules and
 6 regulations of the department for a period of 6 days,
 7 inclusive of the dates indicated on the license.**
- ತ Section 5. Section 87-2-304. MCA: is amended to read: 9 #87-2-304. Class 8-4--one-day nonresident fishing 10 license. Any person not a resident, as defined in 87-2-102, 11 who is a holder of a valid wildlife conservation license, 12 upon payment of the sum of 62 14 to any agent of the department authorized to issue fishing and hunting licenses, 13 14 shall be entitled to a 1-day nonresident fishing license 15 which shall authorize the holder to fish with hook and line as prescribed by rules and regulations of the department for 16 17 1 calendar day as indicated on the license." 18 Section 6.
