Contributions unpaid on the date on which they are due and payable, as provided by subsections (1) and (2) of 39-51-1103 and subsection (2) of 39-51-1106, shall be subject to a penalty assessment of \$10 or 10% of the contribution due, whichever is greater, and shall bear interest at the rate of 1% per month-or-fraction-thereof.

23 (2) Interest and penalty penalties collected pursuant to this section shall be paid into the unemployment 25 compensation administration trust fund.

1 (3) When failure to pay contributions in time and 2 before delinquency was not caused by willful intent of the employer and for good cause shown, the division may abate the penalty for late filing or late payment or both. Interest shall not be subject to abatement.
