5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION
6 39-51-1301, MCA, TO CLARIFY THE METHOD OF CHARGING INTEREST
7 ON PAST-DUE CONTRIBUTIONS."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 39-51-1301, MCA, is amended to
11 read:

12 "39-51-1301. Penalty and interest on past-due
13 contributions. (1) Contribution reports not made and filed
14 on the date on which they are due, as provided by
15 subsections (1) and (2) of 39-51-1103 and subsection (2) of
16 39-51-1106, shall be subject to a penalty assessment of \$10.
17 Contributions unpaid on the date on which they are due and
18 payable, as provided by subsections (1) and (2) of
19 39-51-1103 and subsection (2) of 39-51-1106, shall be
20 subject to a penalty assessment of \$10 or 10% of the
21 contribution due, whichever is greater, and shall bear
22 interest at the rate of 1% per month-or-fraction-thereof.

23 (2) Interest and penalty penalties collected pursuant
24 to this section shall be paid into the unemployment
25 compensation administration trust fund.

1 (3) When failure to pay contributions in time and
2 before delinquency was not caused by willful intent of the
3 employer and for good cause shown, the division may abate
4 the penalty for late filing or late payment or both.
5 Interest shall not be subject to abatement."
