5    A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE REQUALIFYING  
6    WAGES FOR RETIREES."

8    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
9                    Section 1. Requalifying wages of retired  
10 individuals. Any individual retired from a base period  
11 employer and receiving a pension, retirement, annuity, or  
12 other similar periodic payment which is based on the  
13 previous work of such individual is not eligible for  
14 benefits until he has performed services from the date of  
15 retirement, other than self-employment for which  
16 remuneration is received equal to or in excess of 13 times  
17 his weekly benefit amount.  
18                    Section 2. Codification instruction. This act is  
19 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 39,  
20 chapter 51, part 21, MCA, and the provisions contained in  
21 Title 39, chapter 51, part 21, MCA, apply to this act.
