 16 notice of the passage of the resolution of intention and
 17 resolution of concurrence, if applicable, and a notice
 18 describing the boundaries for the proposed district, the
 19 general characteristics of the collection system, and the
 20 estimated costs, designating the time and place where the
 21 commissioners will hear and pass upon protests made against
 22 the operation creation of the proposed district and stating
 23 that a description of the boundaries for the proposed
 24 district is included in the resolution on file in the county
 25 clerk's office.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-13-208, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-13-208. Notice of resolutions of intention and concurrence -- hearing. (1) The commissioners must give notice of the passage of the resolution of intention and resolution of concurrence, if applicable, and a notice describing the boundaries for the proposed district, the general characteristics of the collection system, and the estimated costs, designating the time and place where the commissioners will hear and pass upon protests made against the operation creation of the proposed district and stating that a description of the boundaries for the proposed district is included in the resolution on file in the county

(2) The notice shall be published in the newspaper published nearest to the place where the proposed district is to be created for 10-5 consecutive days in a daily newspaper MUST BE PUBLISHED FOR 7 CONSECUTIVE DAYS IN THAT NEWSPAPER NEAREST TO THE PLACE WHERE THE PROPOSED DISTRICT IS TO BE CREATED. IF THE NEAREST NEWSPAPER IS A WEEKLY NEWSPAPER, THE NOTICE MUST BE PUBLISHED FOR TWO CONSECUTIVE WEEKS AND POSTED IN THREE PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE PROPOSED DISTRICT or in two issues of a weekly newspaper and posted in three public places within the boundaries of the proposed district.

(3) A copy shall be mailed by first class mail to every person, firm or corporation having real property within the proposed district listed upon the last completed assessment list for county taxes the same day the notice is first published."

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. THIS ACT IS EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE AND APPROVAL.

IF THE NEAREST NEWSPAPER IS A WEEKLY NEWSPAPER, THE NOTICE MUST BE PUBLISHED FOR TWO CONSECUTIVE WEEKS AND POSTED IN THREE PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE PROPOSED DISTRICT or in two issues of a weekly newspaper and posted in three public places within the boundaries of the proposed district.

(3) A copy shall be mailed by first class mail to every person, firm, or corporation having real property within the proposed district listed upon the last completed assessment list for county taxes the same day the notice is first published."
