5    A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED:    "AN ACT MODIFYING THE EXEMPTION  
6    FROM SURVEYING AND PLATTING REQUIREMENTS FOR LANDS ACQUIRED  
7    FOR STATE HIGHWAYS; AMENDING SECTION 76-3-209, MCA."

9    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10        Section 1. Section 76-3-209, MCA, is amended to read:

11        "76-3-209. Exemption from surveying and platting  
12        requirements for lands originally acquired for state  
13        highways. Instruments ~~of transfer of land which is by which~~  
14        ~~the department of highways transfers land that it originally~~  
15        acquired for state highways may refer by parcel and project  
16        number to state highway plans which have been recorded ~~in~~  
17        ~~compliance with 76-3-209 filed with the clerk and recorder~~  
18        and are exempted from the surveying and platting  
19        requirements of this chapter. If such parcels are not shown  
20        on highway plans of record, instruments of transfer of such  
21        parcels shall be accompanied by and refer to appropriate  
22        certificates of survey and plats when presented for  
23        recording."
